Welcome to Rocky Railway Games Day 4. Today we are talking about how Jesus' power lets us live forever. (*Trust Jesus!*)

Game 1- Cross the Divide

WHAT YOU NEED:

Beach Ball from VBS Kit. (1 for every two kids)

HOW TO PLAY:

- Form pairs- If you have an uneven number, they can form one trio.
- Give each pair a beach ball.
- Have pairs spread out with partners and facing each other and a few feet between you.
- Ask pairs to pretend they're standing on opposite sides of a mountain divide along Rocky Railway and have to get a train—a ball—across the divide.
- Have pairs toss a ball back and forth to each other. Every time they have a successful
 toss and catch, each partner should take a step backward and away from each other.
 Then toss and catch again.
- Do this over and over until pairs can't get the ball to each other anymore.

Wrap Up:

This game shows us what sin—the wrong things we all think, say, and do—does to us. Sin puts an impossible divide between us and God. But nothing's impossible for Jesus! Jesus made a way for all our sins to be forgiven by dying on the cross and rising again so the divide between us and God goes away, forever. Jesus' power lets us live forever. (Trust Jesus!)

Game 2-Get to the Cross

What you need:

- 2 Cardboard Rectangles per team (in VBS kit)
- 1 Cross Cardstock Paper per team (in VBS kit)

How to Play:

Divide the players into equal teams. The goal is step on a cardboard pieces then move the next cardboard piece in front of you. Step on it until you get to the cross. The player cannot slide the paper with their feet. They must pick up the cardboard piece and put it in front of them. The team that gets to the cross first wins.

Another way to play is for someone to help you to get closer to Jesus. One person moves the cardboard for the other person who is stepping on it to get to the cross.

Wrap Up:

We can share the good news of Jesus with others to draw them closer to Jesus. Think of ways you can share the good news of Jesus with your friends and neighbors. In today's game, we were getting closer to Jesus and helping others to get closer to Jesus. We can remember Jesus' power lets us live forever. (*Trust Jesus!*)
